# TOURNAMENT RULES AND REGULATIONS

(Read these Rules and Regulations carefully)

## FAILURE TO READ IS NO EXCUSE

1. The rules and information listed are important and should be read carefully before entry is completed. Entry forms not filled in properly and completely will be returned.
2. Entries for this tournament are open only to members that belong to BOTH the National Bowling Association and USBC. Additionally, all applicants must be members of either the Los Angeles, San Diego, Inland Empire Bowling Senates or from a guest senate that has been officially invited by the So. California Tri-Senates.
3. No entries will be accepted after the closing date of the tournament.
4. Personal checks will not be accepted. Fees may be paid by bank checks, money orders, certified checks.
5. The tournament will be operated under strict compliance with TNBA and USBC rules.
6. **HANDICAP** for this Tournament will be **100% of 210** for each bowler.
7. Bowlers must use their highest "book" average based on a minimum of 21 games for 2008-2009 season as of April 15th 2009. If a bowler's average as of April 15th 2008 is 10 pins or more higher, then that average must be used. If no average for the last two seasons, use the highest and most current sanctioned average for 21 games or more (the most current league sheet will be required and must be presented prior to the tournament). All others must bowl scratch (210). USBC rules 319a-2 and 319d are waived for this tournament. Rules 319a-3 and 319e applies.
8. A bowler whose high league average is 210 or less shall be subject to being re-rated and in such a case, he or she shall be notified and re-rated before the start of the tournament in accordance with USBC rule 319c.
9. **NO REFUNDS.** Fees after being received will not be refunded except in dire emergency, such as an employees strike, employees lockout, fire, acts of God, or anything else management has no control over.
10. One hundred percent (100%) of prize fund will be returned. There will be at least one prize for every eight entries. The Tournament Committee shall prepare the prize list after the entries are closed and the same shall be posted at the bowling lanes where the tournament is being conducted.
11. Unofficial tournament results will be distributed within 7 days after the completion of the event. If no discrepancies are made, the official tournament results and prize fund will be distributed within 14 days after the completion of the tournament. Brackets and side pots will be paid the same day of the tournament, immediately after competition. Once paid all results are final.
12. No hats or caps allowed during tournament play.
13. Tournament Committee reserves the right to disqualify any bowler not in compliance with the rules of the tournament.
14. Prizes. Championships will be determined by the greatest total of handicap pin fall.
15. Substitutes will be allowed. Once a substitute starts to bowl, he/she must complete all three games.
16. Each participant must wear the approved uniform of that senate.
17. Each participant must compete for the senate they received their membership from. The only exceptions will be for last minute substitutes on the day of the tournament & approved by the tournament directors. Substitute scores from a different senate will not count towards the senate's totals.
18. The total number of entries submitted by each of the three senates will be the same. The limitation on the total number of lanes available at the host bowling center will determine how many teams may be accepted by each senate. A senate may elect to use a qualifying round or other methods to determine which teams are officially submitted by that senate in the event they have more entries than allowed.
19. The Senate champion will be determined by the greatest total of handicap pin fall from sum of all the teams submitted by each senate.
